






Climate

- UHC is pivotal for health resilience post-pandemic.
- Funding for UHC is critical, with a notable \$1.7 trillion SDG shortfall.
- Climate action must align with UHC to address health inequities.
- GHS depends on UHC for effective disease outbreak responses.
- Strong primary healthcare is the keystone for UHC & GHS integration.



What is Universal Health Coverage (UHC)?

- → Defined as all people receiving needed health services without suffering financial hardship
- → A specific goal (3.8) within the Sustainable Development (SDG) Agenda
- → "The umbrella for delivering health targets... a driver of social justice, human rights and inclusive economic growth"
